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Build your career in the exciting field of event management

The number and type of events conducted in Australia and internationally has grown exponentially over the past decade. This growth has resulted from governments seeking to leverage events for economic purposes, along with an expanded recognition of the role events play in areas such as marketing communications, information sharing, organisational learning and community development.

While the current Covid 19 situation has temporarily restricted the ability to conduct in person events, this situation is changing in line with ever higher community vaccination rates. Additionally, many events have now transitioned to online or hybrid formats. The need, therefore, for trained professionals capable of planning and delivering events of various types (conferences,

product launches, exhibitions, seminars/ workshops, sporting events, parades, networking and social events) has remained, and will continue to grow. This program contributes to meeting this need by providing a grounding in the key skills and knowledge required to successfully project manage the full spectrum of events and their delivery formats (live, hybrid and virtual).

What makes this program unique?

The Executive Certificate in Event Management has been delivered to over 4000 participants in 10 countries, including Singapore where it is now in its 10th year. It is based on the texts written by its presenters which are used in colleges and universities internationally, as well as by event professionals.
